Chairman Kinney called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

The Chairman opened the meeting to public comment. None was received.

The Board Secretary-Accountant provided a review of the operating budgets and operating fund. Figures are up to date through today with the exception of township receivables. MTF funds are very similar to last year. Minor activity to-date on Federal/State Aid projects. Heavy maintenance accounts have some activity at this time; mostly special maintenance due to chipseal. Storm damage cleanup from last week is approximately \$50,000 to date; much more cleanup to follow.
