### **Maintenance Operations**

- Tree trimming/removals service requests county-wide (weather dependent).
- Potholes- county wide.
- Gravel roads- scraping dependent on weather

#### **Engineering**

- CR374 from Red Arrow Highway to 45<sup>th</sup> Street, Lawrence/Paw Paw Townships; trees completed, burning brush continues.
- 80<sup>th</sup> Avenue from M40 to 29<sup>th</sup> Street, Porter Township; contractor has begun tree clearing work. (see picture below)
- Preventative Maintenance scheduled for 10 bridges in 2020. <u>TENTATIVE</u> start dates were sent last week. Signs have been posted for the bridge on Red Arrow Highway over Pine Creek in Hartford Township. Work begins this week.

#### **Miscellaneous**

- On March 10<sup>th</sup> voters will make decisions on several different ballot proposals, including the proposed road millage.
- Seasonal Weight Restrictions commonly called "Frost Laws" have NOT gone into effect.
  Weather conditions are monitored and the restrictions will be announced if necessary.
