RESOLUTION #2017-23 - CERTIFICATION OF BOARDMAN AVENUE, SOUTH HAVEN TOWNSHIP, AS A COUNTY LOCAL ROAD

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Road Commissioners for the County of Van Buren, Michigan, held in the offices of the Board, 325 West James Street, Lawrence, Michigan, on Wednesday, September 20, 2017 it was moved by Commissioner Chester M. Ray, and seconded by Commissioner Reginald D. Boze to adopt the following Resolution:

IT IS RESOLVED THAT Boardman Avenue, also known as Chambers Street, being located within the bounds of C.O. Monroe's Subdivision in the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 11, Town 1 South, Range 17 West, South Haven Township, Van Buren County, Michigan, beginning at the Centerline of Cherry Street and continuing East for 792' be adopted into the County Road System

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this portion of Highway has a defined line, has been used and traveled by the public for 40 plus years, without interruption, in an open, notorious and exclusive public manner, and that the road was used and worked on by public authorities.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the above-described roadway known as Chambers Street (Boardman Avenue) be, and the same is hereby certified as a County Local Road.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County of Van Buren, served by first class mail upon the Clerk of the Township of South Haven, and also published once each week for three (3) successive weeks in the *Courier-Leader*, a newspaper printed and circulated in the County.
